What is EYE

Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs

- EU-funded exchange programme for entrepreneurs (individuals!) from the 28 EU members states and 10 additional countries.
- 1-6 months exchanges for new entrepreneur (NE) with experienced entrepreneur (HE) abroad
- Opportunity to exchange knowledge, business ideas, contacts and experiences
- Financial support is provided by the programme for the stay abroad (amount depends on destination and length of exchange)



New Entrepreneur

Would be entrepreneur or Newly established entrepreneur (less than 3 years of experience)

Host Entrepreneur

Experienced entrepreneur with more than 3 years of experience

Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs Global

Extend the Erasmus for Young Entrepreneur s exchange programme to markets outside Europe

US

Israel

Singapore

Pilot project is running from March 2018- March 2021

Transfer of knowledge and experience between European new entrepreneurs and experienced entrepreneurs based outside Europe, for 1-3 months

Funding for the stay of the new entrepreneur is provided by the European Union (1000EUR per month financial support and 600/800EUR for travel)

EYE Global is open only to EU nationals, residing in the EU Member States

All other eligibility criteria remain the same as Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs (years of experience, documents required, etc.)

- Business plan

3 Finding a suitable HE

Different ways- through online platform, individual research and/or with help from EYE Global.

4 Start your exchange

Entrepreneurs will be supported during the preparation and the implementation of the exchange by their IO, the host's IO and the EYE Global consortium.
